१. खरेदीची व्याप्ती:-

आदिवासी विकास विभागांतर्गत असलेल्या शासकीय आश्रमशाळा, अनुदानित आश्रमशाळा, एकलव्य मॉडेल रेसिडेन्शियल स्कुलची तपासणी तसेच त्यामधील पायाभूत सुविधांची तपासणी करण्याच्या अनुषंगाने "आश्रमशाळा महा-निरिक्षण" कार्यप्रणाली विकसित करण्याकरिता मोहोरबंद लिफाफ्यामध्ये इच्छुक पुरवठादार/प्राधिकृत वितरक/विक्रेते यांच्याकडून सोबत जोडलेल्या स्पेशिफिकेशननुसार दरपत्रके मागविण्यात येत आहेत.

Scope of Work

Maharashtra, with a total geographical area of 307,713 sq. km, of which 50,757 sq. km is designated as Scheduled Area, is home to a significant population of Scheduled Tribes (STs), making up 9.35% of its total populace as per the 2011 census. The state boasts over forty-five tribal communities, including three Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) - Katkari, Kolam, and Madia. The Tribal Development Department is committed to fostering development through participatory methods and technological innovations, aiming at comprehensive growth in education, healthcare, skill development, and more, to ensure an inclusive and equitable society.

Under the Tribal Development Department, there are four Additional Commissioners and 30 Integrated Tribal Development Project Offices at Thane, Nashik, Amravati and Nagpur through which the state and central government schemes for tribal people are implemented. There is an elaborate network of Government Ashram Schools, Anudanit Schools, Eklavya Model Residential Schools, Hostels, etc. The institutional structure of Tribal Development Corporation, Shabarai Mahamandal, exist to deal with the livelihood issues of the tribal. Tribal Research and Training Institute (TRTI), is established for conducting research and training related to the field of promoting Tribal culture and their Welfare

The department has used the latest developments in the field of technology and built various portals to cater to the needs of various schemes. The various data bases are getting created to monitor the implementation of various services as well as to aid in planning the scheme in a better manner. The department has also ensured installation of CCTV across the network of schools and hostels to ensure monitoring of the student activities and to create a safe environment for them. The scheme of Centralized kitchen is created to address distribution of quality food to more than hundred ashram schools. The department is planning to leverage the technology use to have a better supervision and control over the various infrastructure facilities and its upkeep in order to ensure quality services to its stakeholders.

In above context, the Tribal Development Department, Govt of Maharashtra intends to deploy Inspection and Audit application for its schools and other infrastructure facilities. The objective of the application is to ensure digital inspections of Ashram Schools, EMRS, Anudanit Schools, Hostels, and other premises under the department. It should be easy to use mobile application, should have ability to capture non-compliances, etc.

The key scope for a bidder for development of the application-

- It should be able to configure different inspection forms in any language in the application. The bidder will be required to develop a maximum of six different inspection forms.
- Mobile app to be compatible with Android 7 or above and should have easy to use interface to submit the duly filled forms.
- The mobile app should work in Offline mode in absence of network availability.

- Should be able to take pictures, upload media files, documents etc. from the app itself.
- App should track the geo location of the user.
- Logins should be developed for all the Inspection authorities based on the Regions/projects/Districts/Agencies, etc., with user management facility.
- Drill-down dashboards are to be developed for the Survey/Inspection on the feedback portal for all stakeholders.
- Should be able to clearly bifurcate on the areas which are non-compliant & non-conformance and assign action plans to mitigate those non-conformance points
- The application vendor will train the users, provide department a support, and should develop the required reports.
- The application should have the facility to plan/schedule various application by the supervising authorities and the dashboard to monitor the progress of the scheduled activities.

The selection of vendors will be based on the least cost based (L1) proposal. The issue of this request for procurement does not imply that the Department is bound to select a Bidder or to appoint the Selected Bidder for developing the application. The Department reserves the right to reject all or any of the Bidders or Bids without assigning any reason whatsoever.

To respond to the above requirement, bidders are requested to –

- I. Confirm that the bidder organization has not been blacklisted and/or debarred by any Government / Semi-Government / PSU organization
- II. Share technical proposal in detail
- III. Provide commercial quotes for the indicative scope of work mentioned above

Please note that -

- a. The bidder must have an existing application that has similar services as envisaged by the department.
- b. The application source code to be transferred to the Department as and when required. The application may be required to be hosted on the NIC infrastructure or any other infrastructure chosen by the department. The bidder is free to use the application for any other organization/department. The Bidder may quote comprehensive price while submitting the bids, considering the said scenario.
- c. The payment for the development of more inspection forms beyond the six forms as envisaged would be made after the due assessment by the NIC officials about the efforts required in terms of the manhours.
- d. The validity of the rate quoted will be 60 days.
- e. The Payment for the application will be made upon handover of the application approved by the Department and remaining payment for the maintenance and other activities will be done on monthly or quarterly basis .The service provider should submit invoices in original to the Department.
- f. The bidder must demonstrate that the required facilities that are envisaged

by the Department exist in their application.

- g. The existing application should be handed over to the department within one months from the date of Work order.
- h. Subcontracting is not allowed while executing this work.
- i. The Bidder shall keep confidential any information related to this service with the same degree of care as it would treat its own confidential information. The Bidders shall note that the confidential information will be used only for the purposes of this procurement and shall not be disclosed to any third party for anyreason whatsoever.
- j. The Department shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other offer received in response to this request for service and shall be entitled to reject any or all offers, including those received late, or incomplete, without assigning any reason.

Bids may be rejected in case – Conditional Bids OR If the information provided by the Bidder is found to be incorrect/misleading/fraudulent at any stage/time during the procurement process OR Any effort on the part of a Bidder to influence the bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decisions OR Bids received after the prescribed time & date for receipt of bids.

The deadline for receiving the bids is 21st February 2024 before 05.30pm. No bids will be entertained after the deadline. The bids are to be submitted in response to this proposal/email.
